

## HITLER'S LEGACY 4 – CONCLUSIONS

After reading these words, is there a take-away, something learned to take home?

What about. . . .

- Adolf Hitler was an enemy. . . .but that was almost a century ago
- The Germans were an enemy . . .but that was almost a century ago
- Many people still admire Hitler because he was powerful
- But it was the Honesty Culture that made him powerful
- We do not have to be Germans to be strong like the Germans
- Strength comes from inside, not from outside
- What we need to do is make sure our taxes are not squandered or stolen
- Standing by our leaders is fine but not when they become dishonest
- Too much loyalty is blind loyalty, and blind loyalty is already complicity
- Corrupt officials do not protect us. They use us.
- Corrupt officials cannot steal without our silence, especially in the polls
- When we stay silent all the money goes to *their* pockets but we are just as guilty
- Voting for the “other guys” is the right thing to do when “our” guys are corrupt
- Not enough well-funded public schools today mean millions of thieves assaulting us tomorrow. Those thieves could have been productive had they been educated
- Not enough money for public schools is a sure sign of corruption
- Voting for corrupt public officials is stealing from our children’s future
- Nations where citizens react to dishonesty are rich (and safe) nations
- Nations where citizens do not react to dishonesty are poor (and unsafe) nations
- The big difference between a rich nation and a poor nation is how taxes are managed
- OUR WORST ENEMY IS CORRUPTION

Approximately 100 social traits have been found to be strikingly different in the Honesty Culture and the Loyalty Culture. For instance, when a Loyalty Culture Leader is rude and disrespectful to other leaders, Honesty Culture people (citizens) are outraged while Loyalty Culture people (tribals) are delighted.



The Hitler’s Legacy -6 and -7 Chapters indicate where the Takers found inspiration for their atrocious culture and where real power comes from.


## **SUMMARY:**
